and the times clocked today, the first  
three teams are just 11" apart from each

***There were still uncertain and changeable weather conditions for the 20th edition of the Millet Tour du Rutor Extrême taking place in Aosta Valley and for the 348 athletes representing 15 different nations. In the second of the three scheduled stages, the staff of the Corrado Gex Ski Club had in store a stage of 2463m of vertical gain in the heart of Valgrisenche, starting from Bonne and finishing in the usual location of Mondanges.***

***The stage featured four ascents and as many descents, with two backpack sections on foot, reaching a maximum altitude of 2963m on Mont de***
